

Environmental Policy

METTLER TOLEDO is committed to doing business in an environmentally responsible manner that minimizes adverse impacts on the environment. We operate our business in compliance with applicable environmental laws and regulations. We strive to reduce consumption of important input parameters and reduce emissions in all areas. We encourage the conservation of natural resources, avoid the use of hazardous materials wherever possible, and engage in activities that reuse and recycle.

We are committed to collecting and analyzing a wide range of data related to the impact of our global operations on the environment, including data on energy and water use, waste, and CO₂ emissions. We are also committed to reporting annually on our environmental impact and on our improvement initiatives through our own Sustainability Reports and through leading third-party services for sustainability reporting.

Our Sustainability Goal. Our goal is to reduce our carbon footprint by the end of 2020 by 20 percent (relative CO₂ emissions per net sales compared with 2010) and at the same time realize financial benefits.

The GreenMT program is designed to help save energy and resources.

To achieve these objectives we focus our activities on the following four key areas: (1) by developing Design for Environment products that allow us and our customers to reduce energy usage, material, and product waste, (2) through energy efficiency projects to reduce energy usage at our sites, (3) in better managing our sales and service fleet to reduce our fuel consumption, and (4) by reducing the environmental impact of our resource consumption, especially in processes related to cooling and packaging.

- 1. Design for Environment:** METTLER TOLEDO has introduced Design for Environment guidelines for new product development and redesign efforts that allow us and our customers to reduce energy usage, material, and product waste. We consider the full product lifecycle by holistically optimizing the use of materials and energy in manufacturing our products and during customers' use of our products, and by mitigating impacts at the end of the products' life.

- 2. Energy Efficiency:** METTLER TOLEDO is committed to reducing our energy consumption in ways that reduce costs and minimize environmental impacts. We do this via projects to better manage the usage of electricity and fossil fuels at the units.
- 3. Fleet Management:** METTLER TOLEDO manages and optimizes the selection of better-suited vehicles for our global sales and service and provides training for more efficient driving of these vehicles to reduce the total cost of ownership, including by reducing fuel consumption.
- 4. Natural Resources & Emission Reduction:** METTLER TOLEDO supports the efficient use and management of resources in our operations so we can reduce risks, costs, and environmental impact. We do this for example by focusing on packaging and refrigerants used in cooling and air conditioning equipment.
