

Environmental Policy

METTLER TOLEDO is committed to doing business in an environmentally responsible manner that minimizes adverse impacts on the environment. We operate our business in compliance with applicable environmental laws and regulations. We strive to reduce consumption of important input parameters and reduce emissions in all areas. We encourage the conservation of natural resources, avoid the use of hazardous materials wherever possible, and engage in activities that reuse and recycle.

Our Sustainability Goals

1. We target becoming carbon neutral in 2020, covering all our Scope 1 and Scope 2 emissions.
2. We seek to reduce our waste intensity by 20% by the end of 2025, compared to 2018 levels (tons of waste per \$ million sales).
3. We target to achieve zero waste to landfill by 2025 (less than 5% of waste to landfill).
4. We seek to emphasize the sustainable features of our products and services, and continue to expand those features.

To achieve these goals we focus our activities in the following areas.

Energy Efficiency and Emission Reductions: We are committed to reducing our energy consumption in ways that reduce greenhouse gas emissions and minimize environmental impacts. We seek to better manage the sources and usage of electricity, fossil fuels, and refrigerants at our units.

Fleet Management: We aim to procure more efficient vehicles and implement efficiency-raising fleet management practices to help meet our regional fleet emission targets.

Design for Environment: Our Design for Environment guidelines allow us to consider the full product lifecycle for new product development and redesign efforts. We do this by holistically optimizing the use of materials and energy in manufacturing processes, during customers' use of our products, and by mitigating impacts at the end of the products' life.

The Group Management Committee maintains this policy on behalf of the METTLER TOLEDO Group, and reviews it on a periodic basis.
